Five key themes that will help telecoms companies and players within the sector to thrive include:

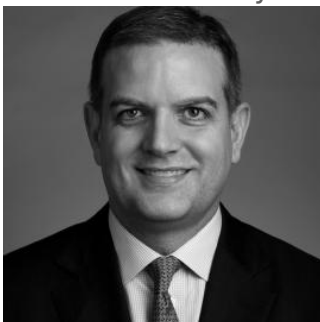


Within the publication, we consider:
