

HERBERT SMITH FREEHILLS ADVISES CHINA'S CRCC ON US\$7.4 BILLION THAI HIGH- SPEED RAIL PROJECT

It is the first high-speed rail investment by a Chinese company. CRCC is working with the State Railway of Thailand and the Charoen Pokphand Group on the project.

The 220km High-Speed Rail Linked 3 Airport Project will connect three major airports and five provinces when it opens in 2023.

The project agreement was signed last week in Bangkok in the presence of Thai Prime Minister Prayut Chan-o-cha and the Chinese, Japanese and Italian ambassadors to Thailand.
