

HISWARA BUNJAMIN & TANDJUNG ADVISES INDOSAT ON US\$452 MILLION SALE OF INDONESIAN TELECOMMUNICATION TOWERS

Leading Indonesian law firm Hiswara Bunjamin & Tandjung has advised PT Indosat Tbk. on the sale and lease back of 3,100 telecommunication towers for approximately US\$452 million.

Indonesian tower operators Mitratel and Protelindo will acquire 2,100 and 1,000 towers respectively, which Indosat will then lease back.
